Dear Parishioners.

There was an awesome meeting last week! The intention to become a mission-charged parish was discussed by parish leaders. It was a joyful meeting with people so keen to see renewal and the focus on evangelisation. Two people from Divine Renovation met with us to see how we were going. It was an affirming and encouraging discussion of the progress we have made and of the people who share in the vision. We all have so much we want to see happen for the kingdom of God, and to realise our vision, yet see the need for patience and for the celebration of incremental wins. We spoke of the 300 people who came to the vision launch panel discussion and of our

new Bishop John Adams who is so keen to support parishes in renewal. We remembered the 200 people who came to listen to Fr. Chris Ryan speak about the Case for Mission. (Recording can be seen on our parish YouTube channel). We spoke of the quiet growing sense of the Holy Spirit in our parish family. We longed to raise more leaders of mission. People who will carry the vision. We spoke of the next Alpha beginning 2 May, trending toward 50 guests. The mission plan is almost completed with the parish pastoral council and mission discernment team working together on this. We are on an exciting journey.

On another note, the parish finance committee has entered a rental agreement with Roderique Hope Trust to make available an ex-convent/presbytery on Brooklands Road. Roderique Hope Trust uses the house for emergency and transitional housing. They monitor the families who occupy the house with support.
