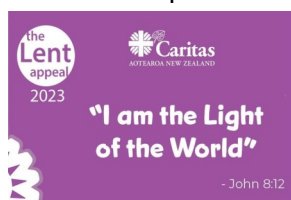

CONFIRMATION WHAKAATURANGA 2023: Registration is open for the Confirmation Programme 2023. If you are 15 years and over and have been baptised, this programme is for you. To register please scan the QR code or see the web site.



The Sacrament of Confirmation is a continuation of the graces you receive at Baptism. When you receive the Sacrament you are sealed with the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

The sessions are held weekly on Monday evenings in St Joseph's Church hall, from 1 May to 19 June, 7pm – 9pm. The programme includes a weekend camp from 26 to 28 May.

You can expect fun games and activities, learning about Confirmation and your Faith, meeting lots of people and making new friends. Parents are required to attend the first session on the 1st of May.
