Important Dates

Pentecost: The Birth of the Church and the Power of the Holy Spirit

Pentecost, celebrated fifty days after Easter, marks the powerful moment when the Holy Spirit descended upon the disciples, igniting the mission of the Church and revealing God's presence in a new, transformative way. As described in Acts 2:1-4, "When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place... All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other tongues as the Spirit enabled them." This dramatic event fulfilled Jesus' promise that his followers would receive divine power, as he said, "You will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses... to the ends of the earth" (Acts 1:8). Pentecost reverses division and fear, uniting people across languages and cultures and giving the apostles boldness to proclaim the gospel; Peter declares, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved" (Acts 2:21). It is often called the "birthday of the Church," because from that moment the disciples moved from hiding to courageous witness, demonstrating that the Christian life is not lived by human strength alone, but through the living, active presence of the Spirit who guides, empowers, and renews believers to this day.



We celebrate Pentecost Sunday this coming Sunday and it would be nice to wear your red or yellow or orange clothes that day, we could let the church ring with colour. Our Pentecost banners will hang from the tower in St. Joseph's with the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Courage, wisdom, right judgement, knowledge, understanding, reverence, awe and wonder.

*If you are 17 you can fill in the form now and will automatically join the roll on your 18th birthday.

If you're concerned about your personal safety, or that of your family, you can apply to go on the confidential unpublished

roll. Your enrolment details will be secure and not given to anyone.

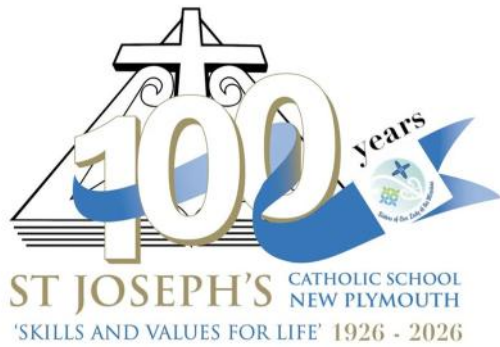

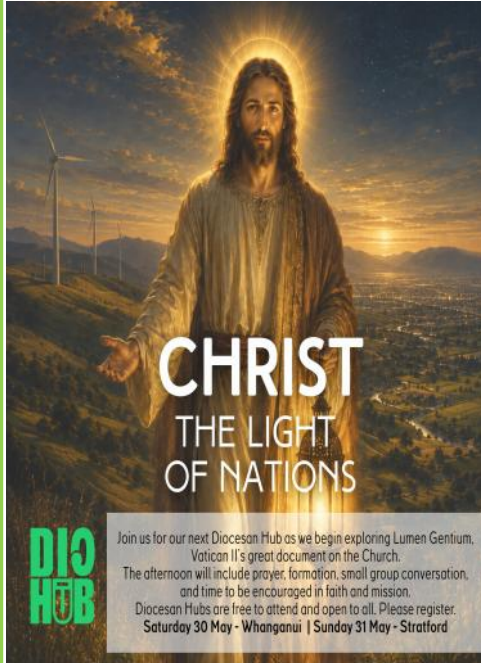

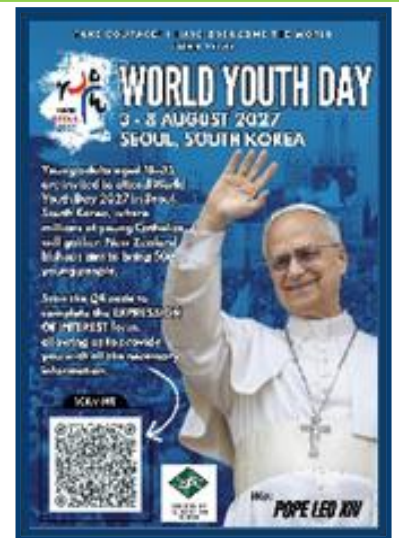
