St Joseph's School Ōpunakē Celebrates 125 Years

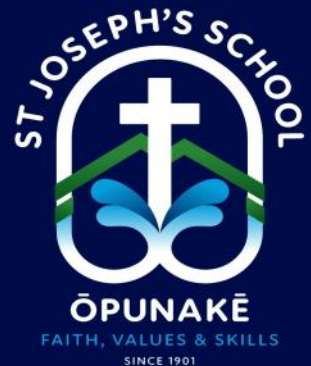

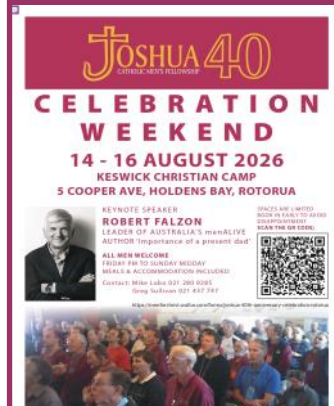
