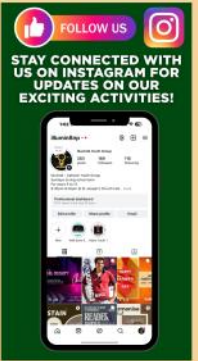
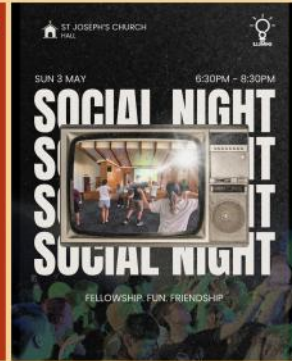

The Eucharistic Miracles Exhibition consists of 40 panels of Eucharistic miracles from around the world, gathered and presented by St Carlo Acutis. Carlo was 15 when he died, and this exhibition is his gift to the Church.

The exhibition then travels to: Stratford (30 Apr–6 May), Whanganui (7–13 May), Napier (14–20 May), Hastings (21–27 May), Palmerston North (28 May–13 Jun).
