From 30 May to 1 June, we ran Confirmation Camp 2025 at Francis Douglas Memorial College, attended by 60 out of 67 candidates and 20 Junior Leaders. The weekend focused on understanding the Holy Spirit and culminated in a Mass emphasising its role in spiritual lives. Activities included messy games for bonding and an impactful evening of Adoration and reconciliation, during which many received the Sacrament of Reconciliation. Bishop John concluded with a family Mass attended by 250 people, showcasing the Holy Spirit's presence throughout the camp.


The theme of this next WYD is "Take courage! I have overcome the world." Pope Leo will be there.
