ALPHA 2025

On the 1st May, 70 people in our community started a journey of discovery as they began Alpha 2025. Arriving a little anxiously, with different expectations, for different reasons and with different levels of understanding, each guest was warmly welcomed by the Alpha Team, as they took their first step on an exciting spiritual journey. Over 8 Thursday evenings and during a Retreat Weekend, a deep sense of community evolved. At the celebratory dinner on Thursday 26th June, amidst the joy, laughter and chat, was a sense of sadness that something wonderful was drawing to an end.

Guest Evaluations revealed that Alpha impacted on everyone's spirituality in some way, a testament to the working of the Holy Spirit. 37 of the guests claimed that Alpha developed their understanding of Christianity and deepened their existing faith. Others reflected that doing Alpha provided them with more purpose in life and almost everyone commented on how wonderful it was to meet new people, make new friends, feel part of a community and engage in deep and thought-provoking conversations in a safe and non-judgemental environment.

The superbly presented Alpha videos shown each week, prompted great questions and allowed guests the opportunity, many of them for the first time, to discover "*Who Jesus is?*", "*Why did Jesus die?*", "*What does the Holy Spirit do?*" and "*How can I be filled with the Holy Spirit?*". Thank you to all on the Alpha team who volunteered their assistance over the 10 weeks – Alpha would not have been successful without your commitment, energy, enthusiasm and smiles.

98% of guests agreed that they would recommend Alpha to family and friends, 16 guests have expressed an interest in the RCIA programme and 32 guests are interested in attending a small group or a follow-up course. Praise God for this.

If you are seeking a deeper relationship with God and more meaningful relationships with people in our Parish, Alpha offers a wonderful opportunity to do so. On Monday 7th July we read chapter 2 of the Laudato Si encyclical - "The Gospel of Creation".

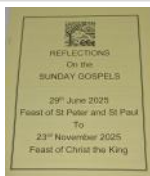
